Undergraduate Minor

The program's undergraduate minor affords students an opportunity to develop a multidisciplinary approach to the study of Asians in the hemispheric Americas. The course of study stresses developments within the United States, but also underscores the transnational and comparative contexts of Asian America and the field's connections with African American, American Indian, U.S. Latino, and Feminist, Gender, & Sexuality Studies.

Procedures

Students must file an application for the minor with the Asian American Studies Program (420 Rockefeller Hall, Tel: 607-255-3320). The semester, title, and credit hours of all courses must be listed on the application. One of the following Asian American Studies Program core faculty members will be assigned as an internal advisor.

Requirements

Students must work with a faculty advisor from among the program's affiliated faculty, and must complete at least fifteen (15) units of credit as follows:

- (a) **AAS 1100 - Introduction to Asian American Studies, and two (2) additional courses in Asian American Studies**
- (b) **One (1) course in African American, American Indian, U.S. Latino, or Feminist, Gender, & Sexuality Studies*; and**
- (c) **One (1) course in East Asian, South Asian, or Southeast Asian Studies*.**

** These courses should address issues of race, gender, or the histories and cultures of Asian peoples. The application must be approved by the Asian American Studies Program prior to graduation.*
